



Meaford Council wants to move forward

For Immediate Release – October 5, 2011

Justice J. Daley issued a summary judgment ruling last week between the Corporation of the Municipality of Meaford as Plaintiff/Defendant by Counterclaim and Pauline Grist et al. as defendants. Meaford has been unsuccessful in the proceedings in May in which Justice Daley concluded that Meaford's claim for ownership of the By-law 11-1854 road, its claim for a restraining order and injunction and mandatory direction to remove the blocking structures, etc., have been denied. In turn, the claim by Grist and Rathbun for their relief and declaration that Meaford does not have ownership of any roadway or strip of land has been granted.

The Municipality of Meaford Council has had the opportunity of reading the entirety of the decision with the input of counsel and staff. The Municipality of Meaford Council has no decision forthcoming regarding an appeal of Judge Daley's decision, or other potential municipal actions at this time.
